Silver Plan Observations

- CareSource's Low Premium Silver plan comes with a higher premium than Highmark's across all rating areas.
- CareSource' Low Premium Silver plan has a lower deductible and MOOP than Highmark's lowest premium Silver plan.
- The copays on CareSource's Low Premium Silver Plan are cheaper in nearly all aspects including PCP, ER, and Inpatient & Outpatient Labs.

HCC Silver vs. Standard Silver Plan Observations

- Highmark does not offer any HCC plans in WV so comparison is between CareSource's HCC plans and Highmark's Standard Silver plan
- Deductible: Both HCC plans have lower deductibles than Highmark's standard. However, the MOOP on the HCC plans is \$800 higher.
- The HCC plans have cheaper copays including PCP, Specialists, Outpatient labs, and Tier 1 drugs


